

Location rules Dutch Equestrian Estate

1. Dutch Equestrian Estate / Arabian Horse Weekend is governed by Dutch law.
2. Riders on horses must wear a helmet at all times.
3. Lunging is only permitted in the designated area's
4. Dogs are not permitted in the building, only dogs on a lead are permitted on the grounds.
5. Smoking is not allowed in the building, the terrace, the restaurant, the halls and the stables.
6. Open fires and/or barbecues are forbidden.
7. It is forbidden to leave any garbage.
8. Please clean up your horse's manure on the parking lot.
9. Please do not let your horse bite on the arena edges and fences.
10. If animal welfare is compromised, the organisation has the right to deny access to the entire accommodation and grounds.
11. It is not permitted to park cars in the horse truck parking area.
12. Please follow the parking instructions.
13. It is not allowed to bring your own food and drinks in the restaurant, lounge or on the terraces.
14. DEE / AHW only serves alcohol to visitors aged 18 years or older. In case of doubt the visitor can be asked to identify him/herself.
Visitors who pass on alcohol to persons under the age of 18 and persons under the age of 18 who consume alcohol will be denied entry.
15. Press must register at the crew office on arrival.
16. Photographers may only enter the arena during the prize-giving ceremonies unless otherwise agreed with the organisation.
17. Entering the grounds of DEE / AHW is at your own risk. The organisation excludes liability for the occurrence and consequences of accidents, as well as liability as a result of loss, theft or damage of goods involving participants, employees, visitors, horses and / or materials.
18. It is not allowed to bring the following items to the DEE / AHW grounds: glassware, tin cans, drugs, striking and/or punching weapons, offensive objects, clothing with discriminating and/or provocative texts and/or expressions.
19. In the interest of safety, visitors must follow the instructions of staff.
20. All persons present must be treated with respect.
21. Recordings can be made at the DEE / AHW grounds. Upon entering the venue, visitors tacitly give permission to the organisation to reproduce, publish and/or use these recordings for promotional purposes.

COVID-19 Rules

1. Wash your hands frequently (at least before going out, when you return home, after blowing your nose, before eating and after going to the toilet).
2. Cough and sneeze into your elbow.
3. Use paper tissues to blow your nose and throw them away immediately.
4. Don't shake hands.
5. Keep a distance of 1.5 meters (two arms lengths) from each other.
